Parking and Traffic Flow

Ongoing challenges with traffic flow and pedestrian crossings. Additional challenges – parents frequently chose convenience over safety and structures (parking signs and rules, speeding, use of the apartment building as parking and drive through).

We continue to work with the City of Calgary to find additional solutions and are still waiting on some 'traffic calming' measures to be completed on the school side of Mahogany Blvd to support further safety. It is a bit of a walk to park across from the school and head to either crosswalk, but with such a busy and main road it is the safest option for our school at this time.

Additionally, we are working with AMA for an updated site review to see if AMA patrols would support safety for students in the program and be effective for traffic flow. AMA has advised that it is unsafe to have patrols at the traffic circle crossings and they do not see a viable alternative crossing site at this time.
