Getting to and from School









Kindergarten times Monday-Thursday

AM Kindergarten: 8:00am-10:50am

PM Kindergarten: 11:40am-2:30pm

Friday (alternating weeks-please refer to the calendar)

8:00am-12:00pm

Students will enter and exit the building through the front doors of the school. At the end of the day, a teacher will ensure hand-off of students to an approved adult.

Please note: there is no parking out front of the school, in the hug and go or in the staff parking lot. There is parking alongside the school on Mahogany Way.

Morning Kindergarten Students

- Students able to take bus in the morning to school
- Parents will need to be picked up at 10:50

Afternoon Kindergarten Students

- Parents will need to be brought to school for 11:40
- Students able to take the bus home at 2:30

Both AM and PM students can take the bus to and from the school on their Friday school time



Take time to talk with your child about everyday activities:






- share special activities together, such as walks to the park
- talk about what you are seeing and doing
- talk, read, sing and play in *your first language* every day
- praise children for their efforts and courage to overcome setbacks











Read to your child every day:



- •read stories together in *your first language* to help your child develop vocabulary, listening and speaking skills
- •enjoy reading different types of books: picture books, information books, nursery rhymes, poetry



- •encourage your child to talk about the pictures and stories as you read together
- visit your community library (when possible)





Build your child's independence by encouraging them to:





- dress themselves (zippers, buttons)
- use the bathroom and wash their hands on their own
- put away toys and help out in other small ways at home
- practice opening and closing snack containers and using a water bottle
- play games, take turns and compromise
- develop a consistent bedtime routine











Your child will need:

- A full size backpack
- Indoor shoes
- Extra set of clothes
- Snack & Water bottle
