Admin Report – Transportation Update

Jill & Christine met with CBE Transportation to discuss the proposed requests previously discussed by Council.

A Few Key Takeaways/Learnings:


- Can only request signage for the same side of the road as the school is on.
- Cannot request signage near the mailboxes as this is not City property.
- Cannot request parking or drop off signage on streets with 2 lanes.
- Parents are dropping off at the CT Transit Stop for STEM Academy (cannot change this either).

Admin Report – Transportation Update

What we have been able to request a quote for:

- Adding a permanent sign for accessible parking
- Adding permanent signage for “no stopping” before CT zone
- Adding two marked crosswalks to increase pedestrian safety
- Adding curb extensions OR calming curbs where crosswalks would be

Next steps: City Roads dept. are considering & CBE Transportation will report back to us.

School Fees vs. System/Central Fees

Central/System Fees include:

- CBE Transportation
- Lunchroom fees
- Student Supplies fees

Schools have no say in Central Fees.

School Fees include:

- Field Trips – swimming, Telus Spark, Zoo etc.
- Calgary Opera
- Spring Musical Production

Schools charge parents for these fees, to provide learning enhancements.


